This position works to promote and protect the health and safety of the residents of Cobb and Douglas Counties.

Essential Functions (include, but are not limited to):

Babies Can't Wait is Georgia's early intervention program that offers a variety of coordinated services for infants and toddlers with special needs, from birth to 3 years of age and their families. Provides the health district with direct therapy services, support and education to children and families enrolled in the BCW program by using the Primary Service Provider (PSP) model.

District Requirements

Friday availability for Babies Can't Wait Scheduled Evaluations.
Document all evaluation sessions with family and other interactions with family according to policy.
Attend and participate in assigned Team Meetings and trainings.
