#### **QUALIFICATIONS TO PARTICIPATE:**

- · Must be early in pregnancy: 14th week or sooner
- Able to visit KSU once each trimester (3 times during pregnancy) and once at 4 weeks after
- BMI in range of 25-35kg/m2
- · No history of previous Diabetes

Participants will receive \$350 over 4 visits for completion of the study

# Babies Can't Wait Services

#### **EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES**

Early Intervention services offered through Babies Can't Wait is available to infants and toddlers with disabilities and developmental delays. Services may include Speech Therapy, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Special Instruction and Service Coordination. Services can help children overcome challenges and learn new skills to maximum learning potential. Programs are available in every territory and state. The Cobb & Douglas Public Health Babies Can't Wait Program supports over 800 children each year.

#### **DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY**

Children from birth to 36 months of age may be eligible if they have or may be at risk for developmental delays. Eligibility is determined by a 5-area developmental assessment tool and/or qualifying diagnosis.

#### WHERE ARE SERVICES OFFERED?

Services are offered in the child's natural environment such as home or daycare. This may be conducted in person or by telehealth.

Providers and families work together to set goals for services.

#### IS THERE A COST?

There is no cost for the eligibility evaluation. If eligible, there is no cost for service coordination.

If therapeutic services are recommended and agreed upon, there may be a cost participation fee if a family does not have insurance, declined the use of insurance or insurance does not cover the



recommended service. Cost participation is determined by using a sliding scale, household income and family size.

#### DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES OFFERED

**Speech Therapy** - Assessment and treatment of communication problems and speech disorders.

**Physical Therapy** - Helps patients function and move better.

**Occupational Therapy** - Help patients develop and improve daily life skills.

**Special Instruction** - Early Intervention service that focuses on supporting caregivers and child interaction to support and enhance childhood development.

**Service Coordination** - Advocates for clients and provides support to families and provides community resources.

#### **HOW DO I MAKE A REFERRAL?**
